SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

Devotional Reading:
Deuteronomy 10: 10 - 15

Background Scripture:
1 Peter 2: 1 - 17

Printed Text:
1 Peter 2: 1 - 10

1 Peter 2: 1 - 10

1. Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocries, and envies, and all evil speaking,
2. As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby;
3. If so be ye have tasted that the Lord is gracious.
4. To whom coming, as unto a living stone, disallowed indeed of men, but chosen of God, and precious,
5. Ye also, as lively stones, are built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God by Jesus Christ.
6. Wherefore also it is contained in the Scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believeth on him shall not be confounded.
7. Unto you therefore which believe he is precious: but unto them which be disobedient, the stone which the builders disallowed, the same is made the head of the corner,
8. And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offense, even to them which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.
9. But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light:
10. Which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy.

IMPORTANT QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

1. What advice does Peter give as five attitudes and actions that should be part of a Christian's spiritual diet?
2. In last week's lesson, Peter compared God's Word as a seed, "a spiritual seed" that is planted in our souls. In today's lesson, what does Peter compare the Word of God to? In Corinthians 3:2 and Hebrews 5:11 - 14, what is the Word of God compared to?
3. In this lesson, Peter reflected on his knowledge of building with stones to point out some spiritual truths. What or who is Peter referring to when he uses the following expressions: "living stone"; lively stones; spiritual house?
4. If we, who are Christians, are a "holy priesthood", as described in verse 5, then what is our "spiritual service"? Does this "spiritual service" come only from the Pastor, preacher, or deacon in the church, or does it come from all who profess and possess Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord?
5. What does it mean for you to be of "a holy priesthood"? What is considered the most important priestly function? (Look at what was the most important priestly function of the levitical priesthood in the Old Testament as a clue for this answer.)
6. Who is the "chief cornerstone" Peter is speaking of in verse 6? What can a person expect to receive if he or she believes in this "chief cornerstone"?
7. The Greek word translated "offense" is the source of our English word "scandal". In looking at verse 8, who is the "rock of offense"? What would have been the "scandal" that many of the Jews believed regarding the Messiah on a Roman cross?
8. In verse 9, Peter draws a parallel between the nation of Israel and the church. With this in mind, what is the nature of "the church"? What are the four ways listed in this verse that Peter identifies the church as the new nation of God?
9. What is meant by the expression "But ye are.....a peculiar people"? Look in Exodus 34: 14 for a clue).

One he could be proud of; the other he could not be so proud of. For the sake of our time today, we are going to focus on the one that he could be proud of and that would be non-other than his bout with the gigantic Goliath of Gath. The scene picks up with Goliath taunting the Israelite army for forty days. Daring them to send just one man to fight him; and if he should defeat Goliath, then the Philistines would become their servants. But if Goliath defeats their representative; then Israel would become servants to the Philistines. While that may sound very impressive not to lose many lives in battle, perhaps just losing one in a major battle might make more common sense. That is, if both sides agreed to the proposal. And there is no indication that either side would or did. But Israel was not really focusing on that part of the equation at the time. They were busy being intimidated by Goliath's size. By the way, have you ever been so intimidated by the size of something that you didn't bother to even read the small print?

STUFFED CHICKEN BREASTS

INGREDIENTS

5 - 6 boneless chicken breasts (skinless) 1 stick margarine
1 small can chopped green chilies 1 pkg plain bread crumbs
2 c. grated cheddar cheese

Pound out chicken breasts. Roll up chicken breasts with green chilies and cheddar cheese inside. Secure the chicken with a toothpick. Roll each breast in melted butter and bread crumbs. Place in baking dish, sprinkle with remaining butter, chilies, and cheese. Cover and bake for 2 hours at 350°

OKRA GOULASH

INGREDIENTS

2 - 3 lbs. okra (fresh or frozen) 1 can whole tomatoes 1 pkg. chicken gizzards
Link of sausage cut up (your choice) 1/2 c flour 1 jar oysters (optional)
1 onion 1/2 to 1 c shortening 1 can whole corn (drained)
1 lb. shrimp (fresh or dry)

Place gizzards in pot to boil. Cut up okra or place frozen okra in bowl add flour and onion. Heat shortening, add okra, stir frequently until tender. If using dry shrimp, place in cup with hot water until soft. When gizzards are tender, mix oysters, okra, crushed tomatoes and juice. Add shrimp, sausage and corn to gizzard pot juice. Lower heat to simmer for 30 to 40 minutes. Season to taste. Serve over rice.

HAZELNUT-CRUSHED CATFISH

INGREDIENTS

6 (6 oz.) catfish fillets 1 c. grated parmesan cheese 1 1/2 tsp salt
1 c. fine bread crumbs 1/4 c. finely chopped fresh parsley 1 tsp coarsely ground black pepper
1 c. finely chopped hazelnuts 1 tsp. dried oregano 1 egg lightly beaten

Pre-heat oven to 450°, grease baking sheet. Rinse catfish fillets, pat dry. Combine bread crumbs, hazelnuts, cheese, parsley, oregano, salt and pepper. Dip fillets in egg, then in hazelnut mixture coating both sides of catfish thoroughly, place fillets on prepared baking sheet. Bake until coating is golden brown.

RICE PUDDING

INGREDIENTS

1/2 c raw rice 1 tbsp. sugar 1/4 tsp. salt
1 pkg. vanilla pudding 3 or 4 apples, cut up 1 tsp. vanilla
3 eggs 2 1/2 c. milk 1/2 c brown sugar & cinnamon
3 tbsp. melted margarine 1/2 c. raisins 1 tbsp. lemon juice

Make 2 cups cooked rice. Beat eggs, add sugar, salt, vanilla pudding and milk, beat together. Then add margarine and lemon juice, beat. Mix rice in mixture. Cut up apples; add sugar and cinnamon, add raisins. (Put apple mixture in first complete mixture). Grease pan and bake at 325° for about 1 hour.

Celebrating June 19th Or "Juneteenth", 2018



Juneteenth, also known as Juneteenth Independence Day or Freedom Day, is an American holiday that commemorates the June 19, 1865, announcement of the abolition of slavery in the U.S. state of Texas, and more generally the emancipation of enslaved African-Americans throughout the former Confederacy of the southern United States. Its name is a portmanteau of "June" and "nineteenth," the date of its celebration.[1][2] Juneteenth is recognized as a state holiday or special day of observance in forty-five states.[3]

Today it is observed primarily in local celebrations. Traditions include public readings of the Emancipation Proclamation, singing traditional songs such as "Swing Low, Sweet Chariot" and "Lift Every Voice and Sing", and reading of works by noted African-American writers such as Ralph Ellison and Maya Angelou.[4] Celebrations may include rodeos, street fairs, cookouts, family reunions, park parties, historical reenactments, or Miss Juneteenth contests.[5] The Mascogos, descendants of Black Seminoles, of Coahuila, Mexico also celebrate Juneteenth

The news of General Robert E. Lee's surrender on

April 9 moved slowly and did not reach Texas until May 1865. The Army of the Trans-Mississippi did not surrender until June 2.[8] On June 18, Union Army General Gordon Granger arrived at Galveston Island with 2,000 federal troops to occupy Texas on behalf of the federal government.[7] The following day, standing on the balcony of Galveston's Ashton Villa, Granger read aloud the contents of "General Order No. 3", announcing the total emancipation of those held as slaves:

The people of Texas are informed that, in accordance with a proclamation from the Executive of the United States, all slaves are free. This involves an absolute equality of personal rights and rights of property between former masters and slaves,

and the connection heretofore existing between them becomes that between employer and hired labor. The freedmen are advised to remain quietly at their present homes and work for wages. They are informed that they will not be allowed to collect at military posts and that they will not be supported in idleness either there or elsewhere.[10]

THE BLACK COWBOY MUSEUM

Larry Callies and Pastor Lorene Daniels

Larry Callies, founder and Curator of the Black Cowboy Museum in Rosenberg, Texas, did not imagine that his dreams of the museum would lead him on a journey that

uncovered surprising and hidden facts concerning his family heritage. It is a heritage steeped in history; beginning in 1850, and continuing until this day. His great, great grandfather, a white preacher slave owner who was one of the renowned Texas Old 300 land recipients, left records in his family Bible with the names of his slave children born to slave women and a slave woman named Annis, the great, great grandmother of Larry Callies.

It all came to light when Mr. Callies was interviewed by Channel 26 News in Houston, Texas, in 2014. A lady by the name of Naomi Mitchell Carrier saw the interview and contacted him. She wanted to donate an 1850's southern slave house. Ms. Mitchell Carrier informed him that her relatives came from his mother's home town of Hallettsville, TX, and that there was a slave owner by the name of Capt. Isaac Newton Mitchel who had children by his slaves. They were given the Mitchel name which was the same name his mother

carried.

Mr. Callies later learned from a distant relative that Major James Kerr was the slave owner and that all the Callies from Edna, TX, came from that Kerr Plantation. He also learned that Major James Kerr was the Plantation owner and a minister of the Gospel who kept an accurate record of all the names, date of births, and the mothers of the children in his family Bible.

Larry Callies takes much pride in introducing himself as a Christian first and a Cowboy second. As a young man raised in Hungerford, TX, he learned to play country music and was managed by George Strait's manager until he lost his voice. He then went to work at The George Ranch Historical Park. It was there where he learned to work with leather and did reenactments of cowboys of the 1800's. He reminds us that he opened a Black Cowboy Museum in Rosenberg, TX, because Ft. Bend County was the place where the first cowboys originated. He relates that the name, "cowboy," came from the slave culture. Plantations had a "house boy", a "yardboy", and (the person who worked with the cows) a "cowboy". The oldest artifact on display at the museum is Callies' Uncle's saddle, dated May 1895. The public is invited to tour and visit the facility.

We need God's protection from him and the evil and temptations he promotes through his demons and those who do not follow Jesus. God has told you what to do, DO NOT FORGET THE LORD, THY GOD! DO NOT WALK AFTER OTHER GODS, WALK ONLY WITH THE LORD, THY GOD! If you trust in God, believe in His promises, and keep His commands, you shall not be deceived, you will not worship other gods, and you shall surely prosper!

One of the earliest examples of man needing the protection of the LORD is in the account of Job and the tragedies he went through at the hand of Satan. This account of Satan is revealed in the book of Job, chapters one and two. This account lets us know that Satan has power; but only power through the permissive will of God to accomplish GOD'S glorious purpose. Satan wanted to prove something to God: #1. If you destroy a man of faith's possessions, he will turn away from his God; but this did not happen with Job; #2. If you destroy a man of faith's family, he will turn away from his God; but this did not happen with Job; #3. If you caused great suffering and pain physically to a man of

faith, he will turn away from his God; but this did not happen with Job; and #4. If you have a man of faith love ones reject him or falsely accuse him, he will turn away from his God, but this did not happen with Job!



Prior to all of this suffering, God had placed a "hedge" or protection around Job that no evil or mishap could touch him. And whatever Job's hand did, he was prosperous. If you read at the beginning of Job, chapter one, you will see the many blessings Job received, the great prosperity he accumulated, and the well being of his family that resulted from this "hedge" or protection that only God can put around his servants. God, according to His divine plan for Job and for us, decided to remove the "hedge" around Job showing us that true faith in Him is not and should not be dependent on how many blessings or even protection we receive. True faith of the believer is not conditional. If we believe that God is God, whether we live and everything is good, God is there guiding our way; and if things go bad in our life, God is still there and will not forsake us, but will always bring us through! True faith of the believer in God means that we trust Him when we understand the things that He does; and we trust Him when we don't. (Job 1:21) True faith in God means that we know that we know that God is all powerful, all knowing, and He is everywhere, so who or what should we fear; or who or what could ever separate us from His love. (Psalms 27: 1-6)

Now returning back to Job, in all this, Job did not sin against God with his mouth. Job waited patiently for the Lord to bring him through it all. When Job's test was over, the Lord restored Job with twice as much as he had before; and even a new family. When you are under attack by the devil, be still and know that God is God! (Psalm 46:10). I don't know what Satan has done to you, but I know this, if you wait on the LORD, He will bring you through it and restore back unto you more than you could ever imagine. Time will not allow me to tell you all the trouble Satan has caused me in my life. Even now as Pastor, just like any born again believer in Christ Jesus, I still wrestle with the wiles of the devil. But I thank God for His Whole Armor that protects me daily from my head to my feet against the wiles of the devil and his fiery darts. "Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and have done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit,..." (Ephesians 6: 13 - 18). And I thank God that He has opened my eyes to see into the spirit realm making me realize even more that I must depend on the power of the Holy Spirit, who is in me, to combat these evil forces. (Ephesians 6:12). We may be under attack, but the Spirit of joy and peace and power still remains in us and will protect us according to His divine and glorious will! Seek God, trust God, and obey God! This is how you protect yourself.
